Notice of Race

Rules

The event will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2009 to 2012 and the SI's for the Series. Competitors will be required to wear buoyancy aids with the CE quality mark clearly displayed. All buoyancy aids will be required to have reflective strips, clearly visible.

Entries

Entries must be a member of ULSSC or KSC. Entry open to all dinghy classes. The Portsmouth Yardstick handicap system will apply. The organising committee includes ULSSC and KSC

The entry fee is double/single hander €10/€5

The entry fee will be payable at registration.

The sailing Instructions will be made available at registration and on Club websites

Registration, Briefing and schedule of races.

Registration will close immediately before Briefing on Tuesday 1st June at UL Activity Centre. Entry Fees must be paid in full before sailing in the Series.

There will be a briefing each Tuesday evening at 18:15 by the OOD which will be relayed on VHF radio on CH 10. Warning Signal for first race at 18:40.

Race Programme

The first warning signal will be no later than 18:40 each Tuesday evening.

The course format shall be indicated each Tuesday evening by the OOD

At least two races scheduled each Tuesday evening in June

Liability Exclusion

All privately owned boats shall have adequate third party insurance cover for any accident.

All boat owners / competitors who sign the entry forms are deemed to have made a declaration that they hold such cover.

Owners / competitors not holding this cover shall withdraw their entry. Competitors are entirely responsible for their own safety, whether afloat or ashore, and nothing reduces this responsibility. By going out to race, competitors confirm they are competent to sail and compete in the prevailing conditions.

Nothing done by the organisers can reduce the responsibility of competitors, nor will it make the organisers responsible for death or injury however it may have occurred. The organisers encompass everyone involved in running the event.

Scoring:

The Low Point Scoring System Rule A4 will apply, modified so that each boat's series score will be the total of her race scores with her worst score/s discarded according to the table below.

Discards applied based on races sailed

1, 2 or 3 races sailed	no discard
4, 5, 6 or 7 races sailed	1 discard
8, 9 or 10 races sailed	2 discards

Prizes

Prizes will be awarded as follows:

- Overall winner receives the "June Series" Perpetual Trophy.
- 1st, 2nd and 3rd overall
- 1st in Class

(Perpetual Trophy will remain the property of ULSSC.)
