



Killaloe Sailing Club Standing Orders.

1. Visitors and non-members participating in events and activities organised by Killaloe Sailing Club must sign in the Visitors book each day they arrive at the club and must abide by the rules and standing orders of the club.
2. Members going sailing must log their boat and crewing details in the sailing log when going on the water and when they come ashore.
3. Annual membership fees fall due on 1st January.
4. Only paid up members of Killaloe Sailing Club have access to club sailing equipment.
5. Club owned sailing dinghies may only be used by members on organised club outings when safety cover is in place on the water.
6. Club Safety boats may not be used by individuals outside of organised club sailing outings and events.
7. Only Monohull Centreboard dinghies are eligible to apply for boat parking spaces at the club. A completed boat parking application form must be submitted to the committee by the owners of boats wishing to park a dinghy at the club.
8. All Sailing activities must take place within the designated Club Sailing Area.
9. On club outings, sailors must not launch until the safety boat is on station on the water.
10. Only members with a minimum of National Powerboat Certificate may skipper Club power boats.
11. All monies spent on behalf of the club must be sanctioned by the committee prior to making a purchase. Payments made by the club will be by cheque drawn on the club current account. Club receipts will be issued for monies received by the club.
12. All members must look out for their own safety and the safety of others while at the Club.
