1. RULES

This Series will be governed by the ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing, this Notice of Race (except as any of these are altered by the Sailing Instructions), and the Sailing Instructions will be posted no later than 5.30pm on the club notice board by the 6th of April 2015 and on our website. www.killaloesailingclub.com

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1 General

Open to all members of KSC Entry Fee: €20 double, €15 single handed, Juniors €5 per person

3. Entry Procedure

- Entries will only be accepted on a completed entry form.
- Entry to the Series will close at 18.30hrs on April 7th 2015
- One of either of the named crew or the named helm on the entry form must sail the boat entered for the series. The named crew or named helm may not sail in a different boat in the same race.

- Race Officer and Safety Crew will be awarded the average points of their races sailed in the Series for their evening on duty.

4. Insurance

All private boats shall have third party insurance cover of not less than €2,000,000 (or the equivalent thereof in any other convertible currency) for any accident.

5. Registration & Race Schedule

Registration: from 17.30hrs to 18:15hrs on the Tuesday 7th April at KSC.

5. Races: 12 races are scheduled of which 6 shall be completed to constitute the series.

7. Scoring & prizes

The Low Point Scoring System Rule A4 will apply, modified so that each boat's series score will be the total of her race scores with her worst score/s discarded according to the table below Discards applied based on races sailed

Up to 3 races no discard (your worst result)

4 races sailed 1 discard
7 races sailed 2 discards
9 races sailed 3 discards
12 races sailed 4 discards

8. PY handicap system will apply.

Prizes will be awarded as follows:

1st, 2nd and 3rd overall.

1st in Class prize if more than three boats in Class.

1st Junior boat.
