1. RULES

This Regatta will be governed by the ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions. The Organising Authority (OA) is Killaloe Sailing Club (KSC).

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1 General

This is an Open Event and all dinghy classes are eligible to enter.

2.2 Entry Procedure

- Entries will only be accepted on a completed official entry form accompanied with the appropriate entry fee.
- Entry Fees: Two person dinghy. €20. Single person dinghy €10
- Entry to the Regatta will close at 10:30 amon Sunday 17th May 2015.
- Briefing at 10.30am

3. Insurance

All boats shall have third party insurance cover of not less than 2,000,000 for each and any incident. On their Official Entry Form they sign a declaration that their boat holds such cover. Boats not holding this cover shall withdraw their entry.

4. Registration & Race Schedule

4.1 Registration will take place from **09:00hrs to 10:30hrs** on the 17/05/2014 at Killaloe Sailing Club Lunches are not provided. Lunches may be ordered at registration and will be delivered on the water after race 2.

4.2 Race Schedule

- Briefing 10:30hrs at Killaloe Sailing Club on 17/05/2014
- Each boat will be allocated its handicap multiplier number (PN) as per the current PY System.
- All boats will start as one class.
- 4 races scheduled, with one completed race constituting a series.
- Warning Signal First Race 11:30hrs on 17/05/2014
- Warning Signal for each subsequent race will be made as soon as possible after the last boat finishes the previous race

5. Scoring & prizes

- 5.1 Each boat's elapsed time in each race will be corrected by its PY Number to determine its finishing position.
- 5.2 The Low Point Scoring System RSS Appendix A will apply. RSS A2 is changed such that each boat's series score will be the total of her race scores, but with her worst score discarded if four races are completed.

6. Prizegiving

Prizegiving will be before 17:00.Prizes will be awarded as follows:1st, 2nd, 3rd Overall.1st in Class if more than three boat in the class.
