NOTICE OF RACE

1. Rules

- 1.1. The event will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2. The prescriptions of Irish sailing will apply.
- 1.3. The RRS changes will apply in full in the sailing instructions. The sailing instructions may also change other racing rules.
- 1.4. RRS Appendix T will apply.
- 1.5. RRS 63.7 is changed so that in the event of a conflict between the notice of race and the sailing instruction, the sailing instruction shall prevail.

2. Sailing instructions

- 2.1. SIs will be available on the event webpage before the "briefing" for this event.

3. Communication with competitors

- 3.1. The official notices will be posted in the event's WhatsApp group. Use this link <https://chat.whatsapp.com/FOUrGb8tqXoFTa5p3TA0HX> or see QR at the end of this document. Notices will also be posted on the club race noticeboard located in the covered section between the common room and the shower block.
- 3.2. [DP] While racing, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

4. Eligibility and Entry

- 4.1. Open to all members of Killaloe Sailing Club, other clubs and guests.
- 4.2. Junior Regatta all sailors aged 9 years to under 18 years as of January 1st.
- 4.3. Boats shall compete in a mixed open division according to the Portsmouth Yardstick handicapping system.

5. Fees

- 5.1. A fee of €30 for a double hander and €20 for a single hander applies.
- 5.2. A Junior fee of €15 for a double hander and €10 for a single hander applies.

6. Equipment inspection

- 6.1. Each competitor is responsible for ensuring their boat complies with the class rules and regulations of their boat.
- 6.2. Boats may be inspected at any time.
- 6.3. Boats are permitted to use sails carrying a distinguishing number other than that under which the boat is registered (as required by RRS Appendix G).

7. Summer Regatta Schedule

- 7.1. Registration will be held on Saturday, 8th August 2026, from 9:30 to 10:30
- 7.2. The scheduled time of the first warning signal of the first race on Saturday, 8th August is 11:55. The scheduled time of the first warning signal of the first race on Sunday, 24th August 2026 is 10:55.
- 7.3. A briefing will be held approximately 25 minutes before the first warning signal. Racing is scheduled for Saturday, 8th August and Sunday, 9th August
- 7.4. 8 races are scheduled.
- 7.5. Up to 4 races are scheduled each day.
- 7.6. No Warning Signals will be after 15:00 on Sunday, 9th August 2026.

8. Junior Regatta Schedule

- 8.1. Registration will be held on Saturday, 8th August 2026, from 9:30 to 10:30.
- 8.2. The scheduled time of the first warning signal of the first race on Saturday, 8th August is 11:55.
- 8.3. 4 races are scheduled, for Saturday 8th August.
- 8.4. No Warning Signals will be after 15:00 on Saturday, 8th August 2026.

9. Risk

- 9.1. RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.
- 9.2. Killaloe Sailing Club and the race organisers shall not be responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury caused to the helm/crew or their equipment as a result of their taking part in the sailing races.
- 9.3. It shall be the sole responsibility of each Helm to assess the sailing conditions on the day, taking into account the weather conditions and all other factors, to decide whether or not to start or continue to race.

10. Insurance

- 10.1. All private boats shall have third-party insurance cover of not less than €3,000,000 (or the equivalent thereof in any other convertible currency) for any incident.

11. Venue

- 11.1. Racing will take place in the sailing area adjacent to Killaloe Sailing Club (Eircode V94 X226).

12. Courses

- 12.1. Race course type will be at the discretion of the Race Officer on the day, depending on weather conditions and will be discussed at the briefing Saturday 8th August. No briefing Sunday 9th August. Separate sail area for Junior regatta on Saturday 8th August.

13. Scoring

- 13.1. 8 races are scheduled,(4 Races Junior Regatta), of which 2 shall be completed to constitute a series.
- 13.2. The Low Point Scoring System in RRS Appendix A will be modified so that each boat's series score will be the total of her race scores, with her worst score/s discarded.

14. Prizes

- 14.1. Summer Regatta Prizes will be presented to:
- 1st, 2nd and 3rd overall PY.
 - 1st in Class prize if more than three boats in Class.
 - Best Visiting Boat
 - Spirit of the Regatta Award
 - Family Boat Award
- 14.2. Junior Regatta Prizes will be presented to:
- 1st, 2nd and 3rd overall PY.
 - Best Visiting Junior Boat
 - Best Junior Helm
 - Best Junior Crew
